Saranac Lake, NY • Cedar Eden Awarded \$45K Indiana Project

Cedar Eden Environmental, LLC of Saranac Lake NY was recently awarded a \$45,000 contract to develop a long-term watershed management plan for a major portion of the Upper Mississinewa River in north central Indiana. The purpose of this project is to evaluate water quality and land use conditions in a 66,000 acre portion of the Upper Mississinewa River watershed, identify nonpoint sources of pollution, and develop a comprehensive long-term watershed plan to minimize pollution and restore water quality. The 18 month long project will begin in early 2004 and continue into the summer of 2005. Funding for the project is being provided by an Indiana Lake and River Enhancement grant through the Delaware County (IN) Soil & Water Conservation District. This is the 14th Indiana watershed study to be conducted by Michael R. Martin, president of Cedar Eden Environmental, LLC.
